

TUFFLEY ROVERS CLUB HISTORY

The late Donald E Hall founded Tuffley Rovers FC in 1929. The Club's Headquarters were in a former railway carriage, which served as Mr Hall's Boot and Shoe repair shop on the Stroud Road at Tuffley in the City Of Gloucester. The Club started its playing life in the North Gloucestershire League. Senior XI Championship honours include that of the North Gloucestershire League and



Stroud and District League (4 times) and in 1987/1988 the Club were Champions of the Gloucestershire Northern Senior League and gained promotion to the Gloucestershire County League.

After two seasons of consolidation the Club won the County League Title in 1990/1991, their application to join the Hellenic League was successful and they were accepted into Hellenic Division One. Progress continued as in the 1992/1993 season Rovers were Champions of Division One and also Division One League Cup Winners and after promotion competed in the Premier Division of the Hellenic League from 1993/1994, regularly finishing in the top half of the table. The 1998/1999 season saw Tuffley win the Norman Matthew's Floodlit Cup defeating Carterton Town in the final. Whilst the Club enjoyed this success, the 2nd XI and 3rd XI also gained promotion and championship honours. The 1998/1999 season saw the 2nd XI win the Northern Senior League and reach the finals of both the County Cup and League Cup, unfortunately losing out on both occasions. Promotion, however, was not possible as reserve teams were not allowed at that point to enter the Gloucestershire County League and progress further up the pyramid system.

The Club continued to thrive in the Hellenic League and managed to win the Floodlit Cup again in the 2002/2003 season defeating Brackley Town over two legs in the final. However, the ever-changing ground grading requirements, if the club was to remain in the Hellenic League, and the financial strain these improvements imposed on the Club forced Tuffley Rovers to make the decision to withdraw from the Hellenic League in 2005 and settle for local football in Gloucestershire.

After a difficult start Rovers were crowned champions of Division 2 of the Northern Senior League in the 2005/2006 season and were promoted to Division 1. After a slow start the team put together a consistent run and managed to claim the Division 1 Title as well as win the GFA Senior Amateur Cup and reach the final of the Reg Davis Memorial League Cup.

A return to the Gloucestershire County League followed and the club finished a very creditable 4th place (2007/8) but the summer of 2008 saw a number of senior players retire. Over the next few seasons, an evolving squad finished 11th, 3rd, 6th and 3rd in the County League, before the 2012/13 Season marked an improvement for the club. After challenging for league championship honours all season, the club couldn't quite maintain the form to secure the title, finishing second. However, this was enough to gain promotion to the Hellenic League Division One (West) for the 2013/14 season.

On their return to the Hellenic League, The Rovers saw a season that witnessed some turmoil – including the departure of manager, Doug Foxwell – to record a decent sixth place finish and some good cup results. This was followed up with the Runners'-up spot in 2014/15 and promotion back to the Hellenic Premier Division, exactly ten years after they had withdrawn from the League.

The first season saw a struggle against relegation, ultimately resulting in the resignation of Warren Evans as manager, before the club retained their status due to a vacancy in the league, after finishing 17th. Mark Pritchett was then appointed as Player/Manager and took the side to consecutive 10th placed finishes, before a 15th place finish in 2018/19. Two pandemic affected seasons then passed, with Pritchett leaving the club part-way through. Rich Cox took over as Manager for a single season, but resigned midway through 2021/22 after a disastrous run of results. Former Manchester United player Neil Mustoe then took over, steering the club away from danger (finishing in 17th place).

Mustoe achieved an 18th place finish at the end of the 2022/23 season, his first full campaign, before achieving a healthy 14th place in 2023/24, with a much improved squad.

FROM THE MANAGER



Good afternoon and welcome to Glevum Park to all players, management, officials and supporters from Malmesbury Victoria FC.

After four straight wins in the league we have had two tough games, both ending in defeat. Saturday at Fairford we were not three goals worse on the day, but like a few occasions this season we didn't create enough in the final third and were punished for that. Tuesday was similar, but we started well and had a good second half when I look back at it.

Today we hope to get back on track. Our home form has been decent and hopefully that continues. Malmesbury have had a bit of an odd season, as I believe they are yet to play at home and found it tough to pick up points but having seen them over the last few years once there home games get going I'm sure they will pick up the points they need to move up the table.



PREVIOUSLY AGAINST TODAY'S OPPONENTS

We look back at our four previous competitive games against today's opposition since our return to Step 7 football, or above, in 2007. Two wins in the FA Vase and two wins in the Hellenic League for us in the four meetings, to date.

16 Nov 2013, Uhlsport Hellenic League Division One (West), Malmesbury Victoria 0-3 Tuffley Rovers

Tuffley Rovers returned to winning ways on the road against Malmesbury Victoria, as goals from Jordan Fletcher, Steve Bick and Mark Ford proved enough to secure a victory away at Malmesbury Victoria.

Fletcher scored on his first start for Rovers, since transferring from Brimscombe & Thrupp, as Rovers romped to victory.

8 March 2014, Uhlsport Hellenic League Division One (West), Tuffley Rovers 2-1 Malmesbury Victoria

Tuffley Rovers completed a league double over their visitors from Wiltshire, as Dougie Foxwell's side found a way to secure all three points.

Despite playing with outfield player Marcus Foxwell in goal for the entire game, Rovers managed to win 2-1 thanks to goals from Mark Ford and Shayne Bradley.

11 September 2021, The Buildbase FA Vase, Malmesbury Victoria 2-4 Tuffley Rovers

After exiting the FA Vase at the first stage in the four previous seasons, Tuffley Rovers finally won an FA Vase tie, albeit having made incredibly hard work of their 4-2 victory over Hellenic League, Division One opponents Malmesbury Victoria.

Rovers made a blistering start and led as early as the 8th minute, when Harry Morgan advanced with the ball before unleashing a beautifully struck effort from 25 yards that sailed past the despairing dive of Archie Walsh, before striking the frame of the Malmesbury goal and rebounding into the net. Lucas Price then scored a second, but Alfie Presley reduced the arrears on 27 minutes, before Morgan and Harrison Archer exchanged goals to make it 3-2 at the interval.

The second half was a barren desert for goals, in comparison to the first period, but Rovers sealed the win with an injury time goal from Lewis Bainbridge.

23 September 2023, The Isuzu FA Vase, Malmesbury Victoria 0-0 Tuffley Rovers

Tuffley Rovers won 4-3 on penalties

Luke Merchant was the hero for Tuffley Rovers, as his solid display in the 90 minutes of this FA Vase tie were followed by an excellent display in the penalty shoot-out that followed a 0-0 draw against Malmesbury Victoria.

Rovers arguably had the better of the chances through the course of the 90 minutes, but were grateful to Jake White, who produced a wonderful goalline clearance late in the game and then came the shoot-out.

After five penalties apiece, Rovers had missed two and Merchant had saved two, but Yesh Lomotey scored Rovers' next penalty and Merchant made a third penalty save to ensure that it was the visitors who progressed to the next round.

History of Malmesbury Victoria FC

The Club was originally formed in 1898, and was known as Malmesbury Town, then Malmesbury United. Then in the 1960's, amalgamated with a successful Swindon Club known as Swindon Victoria

The Club has played in various locations in and around the Town before eventually settling on the present site, known as The Flying Monk Ground. The ground was previously owned by the pub known as The Flying Monk.

There have been ups and downs over the past few years, but in 1999/2000 the Club was extremely successful with both Saturday sides winning their respective Leagues for the first time since 1974. The first team won the Wiltshire Premier League to clinch promotion to the Hellenic League, with the reserves winning the equivalent Junior Division to gain promotion to the Premier Division.

During their first season in the Hellenic League the first team acquitted themselves well to finish 4th in the League. Since then things have been much harder to finish in the top half of the league, but in 2001/2002 the Club did win the Wiltshire Senior Cup. 2004/2005 saw the Club decide to start an Under 18's team in the Wiltshire Floodlit League.

The Club has made huge steps to improve the facilities, in the summer of 2004 the giant step of installing floodlights was completed and the summer of 2005 saw the complete refurbishment of the Clubhouse.

In the 2006/07 season, we were unlucky not to get promotion into the Hellenic Premier League, finishing in fourth place. The following season 2007/08, we had a poor start, and half way through, after a change of management finished the season in 15th place.

The 2008/09 season saw the Club finish in the runners-up spot in Division 1 West, and with it came promotion to the Hellenic Premier Division, this being the Club's highest level of football in its history. However, the Club was relegated at the end of 2009/10 as the ground had not reached the required standard to continue in that division.

After dropping down and returning to a focus on local players, the club saw great success in the Wilts premier league, ending in being champions in 2014/15 season and gaining promotion to the Western League for 2016/17 season and finishing in a very respectable 9th position. Following a mid-table finish in 2017/18, League re-structuring has seen the club return to the Hellenic League in the 1 West Division where we look forward to renewing old friendships and making new ones.

The Club is in the early discussion stages to move to a new ground close to the present one, but high enough not to have to worry about flooding.

Whether he was playing in defence, midfield or in an attacking role, or even in goal on occasion, Marcus never let anyone down and his record of 32 goals in 302 games doesn't do justice to a player who could frequently produce a powerful shot from distance.

Like Warren Mann, Marcus played in the period before our current history was being recorded and so his appearance total is only calculated from Step 7 up to Step 5, which understates his contribution to the club. He was a good servant and was part of a family who gave a lot of time and energy to Tuffley Rovers. It is great to see him doing well in his first managerial role.




