

FROM THE EDITOR



Welcome to Glevum Park this afternoon everyone and welcome to all our visitors, notably the players, management team, committee and supporters of Mangotsfield United FC.

We are on a reasonable run of form, which is nice to be able to say, but this will be a very tough game today. Both Muzzy and Booner have referenced Mangotsfield's good form in the season to date, made all the more impressive because all their games have been played away from home, as their pitch has been converted to 3G (or is it 4G?!?), although it will be ready for games very shortly, as I understand it.

Thinking of our visitors' run of away games, as well as our own progress past the half-way point of the league programme (by the first Saturday in November, nonetheless!), as well as the expanding number of 3G/4G pitches in the league caused me to reflect on how the fixtures are scheduled in the Uhlsport Hellenic League.

We are on course to finish our season in the first week of March 2025. Cup competitions might extend our season, but our improved drainage (which is the second improving feature for teams with grass pitches at this level) means postponements might be kept to a minimum. Mangotsfield are due to finish that same weekend and their chances of postponements extending the season are slimmer than our own, given their move to an all-weather surface. Most sides have already completed 17+ league games, so all are currently on track to finish at that stage of the season. Surely that isn't good for the game?

There is a careful balance to be struck between what used to be common (four games each week in the final weeks of the season, for example) and having the season finish too early. Clubs like ours rely on income from Saturday football above other income, so I certainly hope we don't see the season end too prematurely. Our victory on Tuesday evening has at least added one more game to our season!

Here's hoping for another good afternoon today. It promises to be a very tough game, so we need to be at our best if we are to get points from this particular fixture.

I hope everyone enjoys the game. Safe travels home.

Today's opponents have had a really positive start to the season, only losing once so far, which becomes even more impressive when they have had to play all of their games away from home due to their ground being redeveloped. I'm looking forward to seeing the completed works when we visit in January.

I've been really pleased with the way the last three results have panned out with three wins from three, from two league fixtures and a County Cup victory on Tuesday night. TUFFLEY ROVERS CLUB HISTORY

The late Donald E Hall founded Tuffley Rovers FC in 1929. The Club's Headquarters were in a former railway carriage, which served as Mr Hall's Boot and Shoe repair shop on the Stroud Road at Tuffley in the City Of Gloucester. The Club started its playing life in the North Gloucestershire League. Senior XI Championship honours include that of the North Gloucestershire League and



Stroud and District League (4 times) and in 1987/1988 the Club were Champions of the Gloucestershire Northern Senior League and gained promotion to the Gloucestershire County League.

After two seasons of consolidation the Club won the County League Title in 1990/1991, their application to join the Hellenic League was successful and they were accepted into Hellenic Division One. Progress continued as in the 1992/1993 season Rovers were Champions of Division One and also Division One League Cup Winners and after promotion competed in the Premier Division of the Hellenic League from 1993/1994, regularly finishing in the top half of the table. The 1998/1999 season saw Tuffley win the Norman Matthew's Floodlit Cup defeating Carterton Town in the final. Whilst the Club enjoyed this success, the 2nd XI and 3rd XI also gained promotion and championship honours. The 1998/1999 season saw the 2nd XI win the Northern Senior League and reach the finals of both the County Cup and League Cup, unfortunately losing out on both occasions. Promotion, however, was not possible as reserve teams were not allowed at that point to enter the Gloucestershire County League and progress further up the pyramid system.

The Club continued to thrive in the Hellenic League and managed to win the Floodlit Cup again in the 2002/2003 season defeating Brackley Town over two legs in the final. However, the ever-changing ground grading requirements, if the club was to remain in the Hellenic League, and the financial strain these improvements imposed on the Club forced Tuffley Rovers to make the decision to withdraw from the Hellenic League in 2005 and settle for local football in Gloucestershire.

After a difficult start Rovers were crowned champions of Division 2 of the Northern Senior League in the 2005/2006 season and were promoted to Division 1. After a slow start the team put together a consistent run and managed to claim the Division 1 Title as well as win the GFA Senior Amateur Cup and reach the final of the Reg Davis Memorial League Cup.

A return to the Gloucestershire County League followed and the club finished a very creditable 4th place (2007/8) but the summer of 2008 saw a number of senior players retire. Over the next few seasons, an evolving squad finished 11th, 3rd, 6th and 3rd in the County League, before the 2012/13 Season marked an improvement for the club. After challenging for league championship honours all season, the club couldn't quite maintain the form to secure the title, finishing second. However, this was enough to gain promotion to the Hellenic League Division One (West) for the 2013/14 season.

On their return to the Hellenic League, The Rovers saw a season that witnessed some turmoil – including the departure of manager, Doug Foxwell – to record a decent sixth place finish and some good cup results. This was followed up with the Runners'-up spot in 2014/15 and promotion back to the Hellenic Premier Division, exactly ten years after they had withdrawn from the League.

The first season saw a struggle against relegation, ultimately resulting in the resignation of Warren Evans as manager, before the club retained their status due to a vacancy in the league, after finishing 17th. Mark Pritchett was then appointed as Player/Manager and took the side to consecutive 10th placed finishes, before a 15th place finish in 2018/19. Two pandemic affected seasons then passed, with Pritchett leaving the club part-way through. Rich Cox took over as Manager for a single season, but resigned midway through 2021/22 after a disastrous run of results. Former Manchester United player Neil Mustoe then took over, steering the club away from danger (finishing in 17th place).

Mustoe achieved an 18th place finish at the end of the 2022/23 season, his first full campaign, before achieving a healthy 14th place in 2023/24, with a much improved squad.

FROM THE MANAGER



Good afternoon and welcome to Glevum Park to all players, management, officials and supporters from Mangotsfield United.

After our last Hellenic League game here, against Cirencester Town, which ended in defeat, we have had two very good wins away, and got back to winning ways at home on Tuesday with a good result against local rivals Brimscombe & Thrupp in the Gloucestershire County Cup.

Whilst being comfortable on Tuesday, we were not at our best but were able to rest a few players on the hour and give vital minutes to others, who have not featured so regularly. The downside was that we also picked up a few knocks and we are left with the position that it is likely we will need some fitness tests today to see how they are.

Our visitors today, Mangotsfield United, are in a rare situation where they have not yet had a home game, which is due to their pitch being converted to 3G. Despite that they are well-placed, with the start they have had, and they may have an advantage towards the season end with a long run of home games. That they have lost only once so far, during all those away games, tells me this is going to be a tough afternoon and we will need to be at our best in all areas.

In our last three games we have scored eight and conceded once so we should be confident going into the game and hopefully we get another positive result to build on this season's total of 27 points, which if you had offered me this many points at this stage after our first game of the season I would have taken it! We are ticking over nicely, off everyone else's radar.

Today is another opportunity to show what we are capable of.







MANGOTSFIELD UTD A BRIFF HISTORY

The 2024/25 season will be Mangotsfield's third season playing at step 5 following 22 seasons as a Southern League club, which includes the voided 2019/20 and 20/21 seasons. After thirteen season's in the "Pitchin In" Southern Football League Division One South previously finishing 9th in 2009/10, 3rd



There has been football in the village since 1888 and four years later, Mangotsfield FC became a founder member of the Bristol & District League (later to become the Western Football League in 1895) but the club folded after 10 years. From 1898 until the 1950s, Mangotsfield FC was disbanded and subsequently reformed on several occasions. In January 1951, the parent club dispensed with the Reserve X1 for financial reasons leaving many local players without a team to play for. These players decided to form a new club in the village and at the start of the 1951-52 season, the newly-established Mangotsfield United FC was entered into the Bristol & District League, Division VII. They achieved five successive promotions and gained entry to the Bristol & District Premier Combination in 1957. The club remained there until 1972-73, when it was accepted in to the Western League.

The Club became established in the Western League during the 1970's and despite being relegated to the first division in 1981-82, "The Field", as they were affectionately known, bounced straight back the following season and under the guidance of the charismatic Ralph Miller, who as Chairman, undertook the task of improving the ground and its facilities, became a force in the Premier, mainly featuring in the leading positions.

In 1991, the club, managed by Harold Jarman and assisted by Terry Rowles, achieved regional glory by taking the (then) Great Mills League Premier Division title, ahead of runners-up Torrington. Disappointingly, they were denied promotion to the Southern League as the ground failed to meet the grading requirements and there followed several lean seasons as the team disbanded. Under newly-elected Chairman Richard Davis, however, off the pitch, things were improving.

Terry Rowles returned to manage the club himself in 1995 and kept them in the spotlight by consistently finishing in the top three/four in the Great Mills/Screwfix League and an appearance in the FA Vase semi-final (losing to Clitheroe), but their ambitions of promotion and Southern League football were always thwarted by the continual success of Taunton and Tiverton Town. It was

considered very important to establish a sound working base, improve ground facilities and secure a long-term tenure on their Cossham Street ground.

In earlier years, the Roger Pullin / Richard Davis partnership had seen many improvements take place, with the installation of Conference-style floodlights and at the end of the 2003/04 season, the Cossham Street end of the ground was covered, together with new toilet blocks and social club improvements. Ex player Andy Black returned to the club as Manager in 1999 and guided the club to promotion to the Dr. Martens Southern League and three successful campaigns. The 2003/04 campaign did not go too well and just before Christmas, Black was replaced by Martyn Grimshaw. Towards the end of the campaign, Nigel Webb came in as his Assistant, but the club could only finish in 13th place, which was not high enough for the planned re-structuring of the Pyramid.

The Management duo made promotion their priority in 2004/05 and the club headed the table for most of the campaign, eventually taking the Division One West title with a 21 match unbeaten run. After 28 seasons at Western League level, the club had spent just five campaigns at Southern League level before reaching the Premier Division. In April/May 2005, Roger Pullin left the club and Mike Richardson took over as Chairman, with a new Board. As detailed at the start of this article Mangotsfield enjoyed life in the Southern League finishing most season's around mid table, but had struggled financially during the last few years.

Sometimes now referred to as "The Mangos", the 2020/21 campaign, started with Glyn Ashton, at the helm. He had previously been in charge of the U18s Floodlit Youth side, but took over as temporary Manager in 2019/20, after the sudden departure of Manager Ollie Price, and bought in almost his entire U18s squad. Glyn Ashton returned to his role of managing the U18/Reserve team for the 2021/22 season as Ray Johnston, along with assistant Terry Moore, took over the first team management role but Glyn returned to the hot seat following the departure of Ray and Terry following some disappointing performances and results. The club, however, were unable to "avoid the drop" finishing in 18th place in a league of 19 teams.

In the summer of 2021/22 Chairman Mike Richardson was replaced by Steve Brown, a new committee was formed, and with a new commercial team in place the club started to enter an exciting new era in it's history.

With Glyn Ashton taking over (once again), following the short managerial spell of John Allen and Josh Bruton, "The Field" eventually managed to finish in 11th place in the Hellenic Premier Division in their first season at that level. Last season an expected higher finishing league place was not achieved as the team finished in 13th place, albeit in a much stronger season.

Following a few years hard work behind the scenes the management committee finally got the news that funding and planning permission for a 3G pitch at Cossham Street had finally been granted. Work started on the ground in early July and it is hoped that the new facilities will be ready for the beginning of November.


